**Market details, set-up & take-down**

**Location.** The Marigold Days Antique Show & Flea Market is located in Mantorville’s Riverside Park.

**Hours.** This is a two-day show the weekend after Labor Day. Vendors must be set up and open both Saturday 8 am to 5 pm and Sunday 9 am to 4 pm.

**Set-up time.** Vendors may set up between 8 am Friday and 8 am Saturday.

**Take-down time.** Take down is prohibited prior to 4 pm Sunday without Flea Market Director permission.

**Clean up.** Vendors must leave their space clean and free of trash. Marigold Days will provide a trash bag.

**Vendor spaces & parking**

**Space size.** Each Vendor is assigned a space measuring approximately 15 feet deep by 20 feet in length, but the spaces may vary in size due to the park’s layout. Most spaces are tightly adjacent, with another Vendor space behind and on each side.

A Vendor’s setup must fit within their marked space, including any vehicle, trailer, etc. the Vendor chooses to keep in the market.

**Reserved Vendor parking.** Reserved Vendor parking is available adjacent to the park. Vendors may inquire at the Information Booth for a parking pass.

**Tents & tables not included.** A Vendor must provide or arrange for their own tents, tables, display materials, etc.

**Space assignments.** Vendor spaces are marked and assigned by the Flea Market Director and may not be adjusted without approval.

**Returning-Vendor space assignments.** Vendor registrations from the preceding year’s participants are processed first IF their Vendor registration AND a copy of their MN seller-operator’s tax form AND payment are postmarked by August 1st.

Every effort is made to reassign the same space as the prior year. However, space assignments cannot be guaranteed from year to year, and same space numbers may not be located in exactly the same place as a prior year. Changes are often necessary due to park changes (E.g., Tree growth and placement, playground equipment, stage and buildings), unused space consolidation, etc.

Requests for additional space or relocation must be received in writing.

**New-Vendor space assignments.** New-Vendor registrations, and returning-Vendor registrations postmarked after August 1<sup>st</sup>, are processed in the order received.

## Fees & payment

**Fee.** A \$75 per space fee must be paid by check or cash with registration to secure a Vendor space.

**Early bird discount.** Registration and payments received or postmarked prior to July 1<sup>st</sup> are discounted by \$5.

## Registration confirmation

Marigold Days will send a confirmation letter, map, and space assignment, if a self-addressed, stamped envelope is submitted with the vendor's registration postmarked by August 1<sup>st</sup> or the email confirmation box is checked on the registration form. Please review this information when it arrives.

## Permitted items

**Appropriate items.** Vendors may sell only items that are lawful and appropriate for a general audience.

**Prohibited items.** Sale of illegal goods, weapons, hazardous materials, counterfeit products, and any items deemed inappropriate by the Flea Market Director is prohibited.

**Selling food items generally.** Vendors selling food are responsible for complying with MN food laws and are required to submit the appropriate documentation with their Vendor registration.

**Cottage food items.** Vendors selling items governed by MN Cottage Food Law (e.g., baked foods like bread, cookies, and bars; canned foods like jams, jellies, and pickled vegetables; and other goods like candy and dried seasoning mixes) are required to be registered with the MN Department of Agriculture as a Cottage Food Producer, must meet food safety requirements, and *must submit a copy of their Cottage Food Producer certificate* to Marigold Days along with their flea market Vendor registration. **Farm & garden food produce.** Vendors selling food that is a farm or garden product that is excluded from MN Cottage Food Licensing (e.g., fruits, vegetables, herbs, honey, maple syrup) must meet food safety requirements and may sell without additional State licensing or registration if permitted by MN food laws. **Food concessions are handled separately from this agreement.** Vendors selling food as a special event food stand, seasonal temporary food stand, food cart, mobile food unit, or the like (1) are selected and registered through a separate process and vendor agreement, and (2) must be licensed by the MN Department of Health. ## Electricity & generators

**No electricity access.** Limited electrical power outlets in Riverside Park are reserved for food concessions authorized under a separate contract; other Vendors are not permitted to use them.

**2026 generator pilot.** In an effort to maintain the charming and comfortable atmosphere that Marigold Days Antique Show and Flea Market is known for, the use of generators has not been historically permitted. However, in light of the availability of newer, “quiet and clean” generators, for 2026 we will pilot the policy of permitting the use of generators with noise emissions of 60 decibels or less at a distance of 25 feet and with clean and odorless fuel emissions. This is a one-year pilot test. Based on our experience this year, Marigold Days will make a decision about whether to permit generators in future years.

### Overnight camping<sup>1</sup>

Overnight camping by Vendors is permitted in Riverside Park for this event; however, there are no RV hookups. Quiet and clean generators may be used *after* market hours provided they do not disturb neighbors.

### Conduct

Vendor agrees to act professionally and respectfully to customers, other Vendors, and Marigold Days volunteer staff.

Excessive noise, aggressive sales tactics, or disruptive behavior may result in removal without refund.

### Weather

The antiques show and flea market operates rain or shine unless cancelled by the Flea Market Director.

Vendors are responsible for securing their setups against inclement weather conditions.

### Liability & indemnity

Vendors participate at their own risk and are responsible for securing their property. Marigold Days provides limited security patrol overnight from Saturday to Sunday.

Marigold Days is not liable for loss, theft, or damage to Vendor’s goods or equipment.

By registering to participate as a Marigold Days Vendor, Vendor agrees to indemnify and hold Marigold Days and Mantorville Restoration Association harmless from any claims arising from Vendor’s participation.

### Termination & refunds

Refunds may be granted if Marigold Days is notified in writing by August 25th and the assigned space can be rented to another Vendor.

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<sup>1</sup> The Mantorville RV Park has a limited number of campsites with RV hook-ups available for \$32 per night. To reserve, contact Mantorville City Clerk at City Hall or 507.635.5170. Note that reservations for campsites during Marigold Days typically fill up very early in the calendar year.

Marigold Days reserves the right to terminate this Agreement at any time for violation of terms. No refunds will be issued for removal due to non-compliance with this agreement.

## Agreement

By signing the registration form, the Vendor agrees to comply with this agreement.

## Other information

**Information booth.** A Marigold Days information booth will be located at the northeast entrance to the park (near the junction of 4th St and Hwy 57) and will be staffed—at a minimum—Friday 8 am to 5 pm and Saturday 8 am to noon.

**Emergency assistance during event.** If emergency assistance is needed while you are in Mantorville, call 911.

**Non-emergency law enforcement assistance.** If non-emergency law enforcement assistance is required, contact Dodge County Sheriff's Office at 507-635-6200, or seek assistance at their office located in the north side of the courthouse at the top of the hill on Main Street or at an emergency response mobile unit typically located at the Sheriff's Garage on Main Street across from the bank.

**PENALTY** — Operators who do not have Form ST19 or a similar written document from sellers can be fined a penalty of \$100 for each seller that is not in compliance for each day of the selling event.

# Information for Sellers and Event Operators

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Operators/organizers of craft, antique, coin, stamp or comic book shows; flea markets; convention exhibit areas; or similar events are required by Minnesota law to get written evidence that persons who do business at the show or event have a valid Minnesota tax ID number.

If a seller is not required to have a Minnesota tax ID number, the seller must give the operator a written statement that items offered for sale are not subject to sales tax.

All operators (including operators of community sponsored events and nonprofit organizations) must obtain written evidence from sellers.

Certain individual sellers are not required to register to collect sales tax if they qualify for the isolated and occasional sales exemption. To qualify, all the following conditions must be met:

- The seller participates in only one event per calendar year that lasts no more than three days;
- The seller makes sales of \$500 or less during the calendar year; and
- The seller provides a written statement to that effect, and includes the seller's name, address and telephone number.

This isolated and occasional sales provision applies to individuals only. It does not apply to businesses.
